

## How learners' progress to the next level

- Pass the final test (the pass mark is 65%)
- If you don't pass the final test, you can still go to the next level if:
  - you have only one or two below target marks in your latest continuous assessments (NB if both your speaking and writing are below target you will be asked to repeat the level)
  - Your attendance is good (75%+)
  - You have good marks in your other tests (65%+)
  - Your assignments are mostly on target or above target.

## Why learners continue at the same level

- Fail the final test and:
  - Your latest continuous assessment scores are low (below target in three areas)
  - Both your writing and speaking are below target.
  - You have low test scores.

## Learners who fail to take the final test

Learners who do not take the final test can progress to the next level provided they have a good reason for missing the test and they meet the criteria above for learners who do not get 65% in the final test.

## Who can study on a 10 week IELTS course:

- Learners who pass the intermediate level in the school.
- Learners whose placement test is upper-intermediate.
- Learners who have an IELTS certificate with an overall score of 5.
